## 67383.2 Definitions

When used in this chapter, the following terms have the meanings given below: "Closed in place" means left in place and closed without being removed. "Disposal" has the same meaning as in section 66260.10, except that the term disposal does not include tanks that are closed in place pursuant to the requirements of this chapter or title 23, California Code of Regulations. "LIA" means the "local implementing agency" or local agency responsible for the enforcement and regulatory oversight of hazardous material storage tanks pursuant to section 25283 of the Health and Safety Code.

"Tank" means a stationary device, designed to contain an accumulation of hazardous waste or hazardous material, which is constructed primarily of nonearthen materials (e.g., wood, concrete, steel, plastic) that provides structural support.

"Tank system" means a hazardous waste or a hazardous material transfer, storage or treatment tank and its associated ancillary equipment and containment system.
