Response costs are all costs described in subdivision (t) of H&SC Section 25396 (as it read on June 26, 2012) including, but not limited to: (1) The cost of preparing and reviewing a Preliminary Endangerment Assessment (PEA) including, but not limited to, the cost of collecting, reviewing, and analyzing data or any activities necessary to complete the PEA. (2) Costs associated with the Department's preparation of a recommendation to the Site Designation Committee pursuant to subdivision (b) of H&SC Section 25396.5 (as it read on June 26, 2012).
