# 70136 Conviction of Crime: Standards for Evaluating Rehabilitation

When considering the denial, suspension or revocation of a license based on the conviction of a crime in accordance with Section 1265.1 or 1294 of the Health and Safety Code, the following criteria shall be considered in evaluating rehabilitation:

## **(1)**

The nature and the seriousness of the crime(s) under consideration.

### **(2)**

Evidence of conduct subsequent to the crime which suggests responsible or irresponsible character.

## (3)

The time which has elapsed since commission of the crime(s) or conduct referred to in subdivision (1) or (2).

#### **(4)**

The extent to which the applicant has complied with any terms of parole, probation, restitution, or any other sanction lawfully imposed against the applicant.

#### **(5)**

Any rehabilitation evidence submitted by the applicant.
