The facility shall ensure that all new staff providing program services shall receive at least 20 hours of orientation and training within 60 days of employment. Initial training shall include, but not be limited to the following: (1) Orientation to special needs of the mentally disordered. (2) Orientation to overall concepts of programs to meet the special needs of the mentally disordered. (3) Orientation and training in specific program techniques being used in the facility to meet the identified program needs of the patients.
