

74719 Services Arranged by Agreement

(a)

When any service offered by the agency is not provided by employees, there shall be a written agreement meeting the requirements of this section.

(b)

The agreement shall include at least the following: (1) The nature and scope of the services to be provided; (2) The rights and responsibilities of the agency or individual providing services and of the contracting agency in the coordination, supervision, and evaluation of the care or services provided; (3) The role, if any, of the agency and the contracted individual or agency in: (A) The patient admission process, (B) Patient assessment, (C) The development, review, and revision of the plan of treatment or plan of care, (D) Patient care conferences, (E) The scheduling of visits or hours, (F) Discharge planning; (4) The submission to the agency of documentation of services provided; (5) The responsibility of the contracted individual or agency to adhere to applicable agency policies, including personnel qualifications; (6) The procedures for determining charges and reimbursement; and (7) The term of the agreement and the conditions for its renewal or termination.
