Facilities shall provide nursing services in accordance with the needs of the clients for the purpose of: (1) Development and maintenance of an environment that will meet their total health needs. (4) Training in habits of personal hygiene, family life, sex education (including family planning and venereal disease counseling). (5) Control of communicable diseases and infections through: (A) Identification and assessment. (B) Reporting to medical authorities. (C) Implementation of appropriate protective and preventive measures. (6) Development of a written plan for each client to provide for nursing services as a part of the individual program plan total habilitation program. (7) Modification of the nursing section of the individual program plan in terms of the client's daily needs at least every six months.
