

76629 Housekeeping

(a)

Each facility shall routinely clean articles and surfaces such as furniture, floors, walls, ceilings, supply and exhaust grills and lighting fixtures.

(b)

There shall be routines and procedures indicating daily, weekly and monthly cleaning schedules, for all areas of the facility.

(c)

There shall be cleaning supplies and equipment available to housekeeping staff to meet the needs of the facility. (1) Cleaning supplies and equipment shall be stored in rooms for housekeeping use only and shall not be accessible to clients unless so specified in the client's individual program plan. (2) A commercial detergent germicide shall be used for all cleaning. (3) Mop heads shall be removable and changed after each day's use.

(d)

There shall be housekeeping personnel to maintain the interior of the facility in a safe, clean, orderly and attractive manner free from offensive odors.

(e)

A person qualified by experience and training shall be in charge of the housekeeping department.

(f)

Janitor's closets, service sinks and storage areas shall be maintained to meet the needs of the facility.
