79313 Patients' Rights

(a)

The governing body shall adopt and implement a written policy on patients' rights.

(b)

A list of these patients' rights shall be posted in English and in the predominant language of the community if other than English, in appropriate places within the CDRH so that such rights may be read by patients. This list shall include but not be limited to the patients' right to: (1) Considerate and respectful care, including the right to wear appropriate clothing. (2) Knowledge of the name of the physician who has overall responsibility for their care, the names and professional relationships of others who will be involved in their recovery program. (3) Be free from discrimination based on sex, race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, medical condition, marital status, or registered domestic partner status.

Considerate and respectful care, including the right to wear appropriate clothing.

(2)

Knowledge of the name of the physician who has overall responsibility for their care, the names and professional relationships of others who will be involved in their recovery program.

Be free from discrimination based on sex, race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, medical condition, marital status, or registered domestic partner status.
