79639 Nursing Service-Patients with Infectious Diseases (a)

Patients with infectious diseases shall not be admitted to, or cared for, in the facility unless the following requirements are met: (1) A patient suspected of, or diagnosed as having an airborne infectious or reportable communicable disease, or being in a carrier state, who the attending medical staff determines is a potential danger, shall be accommodated in a room, vented to the outside if airborne, and provided with a separate toilet, hand washing facility, soap dispenser and individual towels. (2) There shall be: (A) Separate provisions for handling contaminated linens. (B) Separate provisions for handling contaminated dishes. (C) Separate provisions for handling any object, article, substance or material capable of transmission of a communicable disease.
