

82040 Denial of License

(a)

An application for licensure shall be denied as specified in Health and Safety Code Sections 1520.11(b), (d), 1523.1(e) and 1550.

(b)

If the application for a license is denied, the licensing agency shall mail the applicant a written notice of denial stating the reasons for the denial, and advising the applicant of the right to appeal, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 1526.

(c)

If the application for a license is denied, the licensing fee shall not be refunded pursuant to Section 82036(d).

(d)

Notwithstanding any appeal, the day program is unlicensed and shall not operate pending adoption by the director of a decision on the denial.
