## **84065.7 Night Supervision**

### **(a)**

In group homes providing care and supervision to 12 or fewer children, there shall be one child care staff person on duty from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.; for minor parent programs this requirement shall be from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

### **(b)**

In group homes providing care and supervision to 13 to 30 children, there shall be one child care staff person awake and on duty from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.; for minor parent programs this requirement shall be from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. (1) Another person shall be on call and capable of arriving at the facility site within 30 minutes.

#### **(1)**

Another person shall be on call and capable of arriving at the facility site within 30 minutes.

### **(c)**

In group homes providing care and supervision to 31 or more children, there shall be one child care staff person awake and on duty from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. for the first 30 children; and one child care staff person awake and on duty for each additional 30 children or fraction of that amount; for minor parent programs this requirement shall be from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

### **(d)**

For purposes of determining the appropriate staff to children ratio, children shall include all children present in the facility.

**(e)**

In facilities required to have a signal system as specified in Sections 84088(d) through (d)(3), at least one staff person shall be responsible for responding to such system.
