84065.1 Additional Personnel Requirements for Specialized Group Homes

Any person who provides specialized in-home health care to a child placed in the group home as of November 1, 1993, shall comply with the following requirements: (1) Prior to caring for the child or when the child's needs change, the in-home health care provider shall complete training in specialized in-home health care provided by a health care professional as required by the child's individualized health care plan, except when (A) The in-home health care provider is a licensed health care professional; and (B) The child's individualized health care plan team determines that completion of specialized in-home health care training for the child is unnecessary on the basis of the in-home health care provider's medical qualifications and expertise.

Prior to caring for the child or when the child's needs change, the in-home health care provider shall complete training in specialized in-home health care provided by a health care professional as required by the child's individualized health care plan, except when (A) The in-home health care provider is a licensed health care professional; and (B) The child's individualized health care plan team determines that completion of specialized in-home health care training for the child is unnecessary on the basis of the in-home health care provider's medical qualifications and expertise.
