84369 Medical Examination

(a)

The administrator or the social work staff shall be responsible for obtaining a physical examination during or after an incidence of emergency intervention when it is determined that: (1) There is physical injury to a child, or (2) There is a suspected injury to a child.

(1)

There is physical injury to a child, or

(2)

There is a suspected injury to a child.

(b)

The administrator or the social work supervisor must see and talk with the child before a determination can be made.

(c)

If no physical examination is necessary, this decision must be documented in the child's record.

(d)

Any post emergency intervention injury or suspected injury observed by facility personnel, or any complaint of injury reported to facility personnel must be reported immediately to the administrator or social work staff.
