

84787 Buildings and Grounds

In addition to Sections 80087 and 84087 the following shall apply:

Areas in the home, including bedrooms, bathrooms, toilets, dining areas, passageways and recreational spaces shall be large enough to accommodate any medical equipment needed by a child residing in the home.
