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84769.2 Individual Health Care Plan

(a)

The licensee shall not accept any child for placement unless an individual health care plan that is fully and immediately implementable has been prepared for the child pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 4684.68. (1) An individualized health care plan prepared pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 17731 is sufficient for a child with special health care needs in foster care provided the plan meets the requirements of Welfare and Institutions Code section 4684.68.

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An individualized health care plan prepared pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 17731 is sufficient for a child with special health care needs in foster care provided the plan meets the requirements of Welfare and Institutions Code section 4684.68.

(b)

The individual health care plan may be combined with the child's needs and services plan, or regional center Individual Program Plan, provided that all the information required by each plan is included.

(c)

If applicable, the individual health care plan must include information justifying the use of physical restraining devices, postural supports and protective devices as

specified in Section 84772.
