## 86521 Water Supply

## (a)

All crisis nurseries where water for human consumption is from a private water source shall meet the following requirements: (1) As a condition of initial licensure, the applicant shall provide evidence of an on-site inspection of the private water source and a bacteriological analysis which establishes the safety of the water, conducted by the local health department, the California Department of Public Health, or a licensed commercial laboratory. (2) Subsequent to initial licensure, the licensee shall provide evidence of a bacteriological analysis of the private water source as frequently as necessary to ensure childrens' safety, but no less frequently than specified in the following table: LICENSED CAPACITYANALYSIS REQUIREDPERIODIC SUBSEQUENT ANALYSIS 6 or fewerInitial LicensingNot required unless evidence supports the need for such analysis to protect clients. 7 through 14Initial LicensingAnnually
