

86535 Conditions for Forfeiture of a Crisis Nursery License

Conditions for forfeiture of a crisis nursery license may be found in Health and Safety Code Section 1524. (1) "Licensee abandons the crisis nursery" shall mean the licensee informs the Department that the licensee no longer accepts responsibility for the crisis nursery, or the Department is unable to determine the licensee's whereabouts after making at least one (1) phone call per day, to the licensee's last telephone number of record, for five (5) consecutive workdays with no response; and sending a certified letter, requesting the licensee to contact the Department, to the licensee's last mailing address of record with no response within seven (7) calendar days.
