

## **86574 Transportation**

### **(a)**

The licensee shall ensure that all transportation provided for children in their care is provided in vehicles that are in safe operating condition and that drivers comply with all applicable laws.

### **(b)**

No child shall be left unattended in a vehicle.

### **(c)**

The licensee shall ensure that children are secured in the vehicle in an appropriate restraint device according to the California Vehicle Code and, if applicable, the manufacturers' instructions for the infant car seat(s). (1) The licensee shall ensure the use of other restraint or protective devices that are required due to the child's disabilities or physical and medical condition. (2) The licensee shall ensure that children are secured in the vehicle so that the child is not in danger of being injured by the vehicle's airbag.

#### **(1)**

The licensee shall ensure the use of other restraint or protective devices that are required due to the child's disabilities or physical and medical condition.

#### **(2)**

The licensee shall ensure that children are secured in the vehicle so that the child is not in danger of being injured by the vehicle's airbag.

**(d)**

The licensee and his/her staff are prohibited from smoking a tobacco product, or permitting any person from smoking a tobacco product in a motor vehicle that is regularly used to transport children, regardless of when the children are present. This prohibition applies when the motor vehicle is moving or at rest. Smoking has the same meaning as in subdivision (c) of Section 22950.5 of the Business and Professions Code, and tobacco product means a product or device as defined in subdivision (d) of Section 22950.5 of the Business and Professions Code.
