The licensee shall ensure that a variety of developmental activities designed to meet the physical, cognitive, social, and emotional needs of the children including, but not limited to, the following are provided: (1) Parent, legal guardian, or family member involvement in the care giving, if appropriate. (2) Predictable and consistent daily scheduling that balances the following: (A) Group and individual activities. (B) Active and quiet play. (C) Structured and flexible play. (D) Rest. (E) Eating. (F) Toileting. (G) Individual attention to the child by crisis nursery staff. (H) Holding, if in the initial assessment plan. (3) Opportunity for increasing self-care. (4) Preparation for transitions in daily activities and changes in the daily schedule. (5) The opportunity to nap or rest without distraction or disturbance from other activities.
