87912 Care of Residents Confined to Bed

The licensee shall be permitted to accept or retain a resident who is confined to bed, if the requirements of (a)(1) and (2) below are met. (1) All licensees shall ensure that the equipment and appliances are available to assist and protect the residents who are confined to bed. (2) The equipment and appliances shall include, but not be limited to: (A) An egg-crate mattress (or equivalent to relieve pressure). (B) Heel and elbow protectors. (C) Partial bed rails. (D) Screens and/or curtains to ensure privacy if the resident shares a room with another resident. (E) Over-bed table. (F) Bedside commode. (G) Urinal. (H) Bed Pan. (I) Wheelchair.
