87905 Wounds

(a)

Section 87905@ Wounds

The licensee shall be permitted to accept or retain a resident who has a wound under the following circumstances: (1) When care is performed by or under the supervision of the appropriately skilled professional. (2) If the wound becomes infected, all aspects of care must be performed by the appropriately skilled professional. (3) For residents with Stage I or II decubitus ulcer, the condition must be diagnosed by a physician and care for the decubitus ulcer must be given by the appropriately skilled professional.

(1)

When care is performed by or under the supervision of the appropriately skilled professional.

(2)

If the wound becomes infected, all aspects of care must be performed by the appropriately skilled professional.

(3)

For residents with Stage I or II decubitus ulcer, the condition must be diagnosed by a physician and care for the decubitus ulcer must be given by the appropriately skilled professional.

(b)

The appropriately skilled professional shall document in the resident's file all

aspects of care performed.

(c)

All used dressing shall be disposed of as specified in Section 87889.
