87920.1 Disposal of Scheduled and Controlled Drugs/Medications

(a)

There shall be written instructions regarding the disposition of scheduled and controlled drugs/medication under the following conditions: (1) The resident's physician orders that the resident discontinue taking the medications. (2) The resident's facility placement is terminated.

The licensee shall have the disposal instructions reviewed and approved by the pharmacist.

(2) Copies of all documents pertaining to the disposition of scheduled and controlled drugs/medications shall be maintained in the resident's file for three years. OR
