

89254 Civil Penalties

(a)

The licensing agency shall assess civil penalties for the following deficiencies:

(1) Not submitting an application for licensure required by Section 89218, Application for License, within 15 calendar days of being served a Notice of Operation in Violation of Law (LIC 195). (2) Not obtaining the fingerprint clearances required for licensure by Health and Safety Code section 1522, subsection (b) as stated in Section 89219, Criminal Record Clearance. Civil penalties shall be assessed as specified in Health and Safety Code section 1522, subsection (c).

(1)

Not submitting an application for licensure required by Section 89218, Application for License, within 15 calendar days of being served a Notice of Operation in Violation of Law (LIC 195).

(2)

Not obtaining the fingerprint clearances required for licensure by Health and Safety Code section 1522, subsection (b) as stated in Section 89219, Criminal Record Clearance. Civil penalties shall be assessed as specified in Health and Safety Code section 1522, subsection (c).

(b)

Repeat penalties for repeating the same violation as set forth in Health and Safety

Code section 1548, subsections (d) and (e) shall not apply.

(c)

Unless otherwise provided, all penalties are due and payable upon receipt of notice for payment, and shall be paid only by check or money order made payable to the agency indicated in the notice.
