

89469 Children's Medical Assessments

(a)

Within 30 days of accepting a "child," the caregiver shall obtain a recent written medical assessment. (1) A recent medical assessment shall not be more than a year old, and (2) A medical assessment for a "child" shall include the results of an examination for communicable tuberculosis (TB) and other contagious or infectious diseases.

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(2)

A medical assessment for a "child" shall include the results of an examination for communicable tuberculosis (TB) and other contagious or infectious diseases.

(b)

The licensing agency may require the caregiver to obtain a current written medical assessment for a "child," if such an assessment is necessary to verify the appropriateness of a home for a "child."
