## **100077.01 Advanced EMT Approved Training Programs**(a)

The purpose of an Advanced EMT training program shall be to prepare eligible EMTs to render prehospital LALS within an organized EMS system.

## (b)

Advanced EMT training shall be offered only by approved training programs.

Eligibility for training program approval shall be limited to the following institutions: (1) Accredited universities and colleges, including junior and community colleges, and private post-secondary schools as approved by the State of California, Department of Consumer Affairs, Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. (2) Medical training units of a branch of the Armed Forces or Coast Guard of the United States. (3) Licensed general acute care hospitals which meet the following criteria:(A) Hold a special permit to operate a Basic or Comprehensive Emergency Medical Service pursuant to the provisions of Division 5; and (B) Provide continuing education to other health care professionals. (4) Agencies of government.
