

## **100093.02 Student Eligibility**

### **(a)**

To be eligible to enter a paramedic training program an individual shall meet the following requirements:(1) Possess a high school diploma or general education equivalent; and (2) possess a current basic cardiac life support (CPR) card equivalent to the current American Heart Association's Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care at the healthcare provider level; and (3) possess a current EMT certificate or NREMT-Basic registration; or (4) possess a current AEMT certificate in the State of California; or (5) be currently registered as an Advanced-EMT with the NREMT.

#### **(1)**

Possess a high school diploma or general education equivalent; and

#### **(2)**

possess a current basic cardiac life support (CPR) card equivalent to the current American Heart Association's Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care at the healthcare provider level; and

#### **(3)**

possess a current EMT certificate or NREMT-Basic registration; or

#### **(4)**

possess a current AEMT certificate in the State of California; or

#### **(5)**

be currently registered as an Advanced-EMT with the NREMT.

**(b)**

To be eligible to enter a CCP training program an individual shall be currently licensed, and accredited, in California as a paramedic with three (3) years of basic paramedic practice.
