

100540 General Provisions

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000 et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings. Therefore, the terms of California Code of Regulations, title 2, section 18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendix in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the California Medical Assistance Commission.

Designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with the California Medical Assistance Commission, and the California Medical Assistance Commission will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code, § 81008.) Upon receipt of the statements of the Commissioners and Executive Director, the California Medical Assistance Commission shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the Fair Political Practices Commission. Original statements for all other designated employees will be retained by the California Medical Assistance

Commission, and copies will be provided to the Office of the Governor.
