## **112155 Case Processing-Non Public Assistance Cases**

### **(a)**

A local child support agency shall seek to establish paternity, if necessary, and to obtain an order for current support which shall comply with the statewide uniform guideline specified in Article 2, of Chapter 2, of Part 2, of Division 9, of the Family Code (commencing with Section 4050), and an order for medical support, unless such orders for support of all the minor children already exist.

### **(b)**

A local child support agency shall enforce any existing valid support order(s) and/or medical support orders established for the family and/or child(ren) as specified in Division 9 of the Family Code (commencing with Section 3500); Division 17 of the Family Code (commencing with Section 17000); and Title 6.5 of Part 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure (commencing with Section 481.010), Title 9 of Part 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure (commencing with Section 680.010); Title 13 of Part 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure (commencing with Section 901); and Title 5 of Part 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure (commencing with Section 1209).
