

112210 Good Cause

(a)

The local child support agency shall suspend Title IV-D services if, the custodial party requests a good cause review by the county welfare department. Services shall remain suspended until the custodial party requests the resumption of services, or the county welfare department declines to find good cause.

(b)

A local child support agency shall suspend Title IV-D services after the agency is notified by the county welfare department via the "Child Support-Good Cause For Noncooperation," form CW 51, as required by CDSS, of a finding of good cause, as specified in, Sections 11477.04 and 14008.6 Welfare and Institutions Code.
