

CDC Health Advisory: Extensively Drug-Resistant Salmonella Typhi Infections Among U.S. Residents Without International Travel

The CDC has detected multiple cases of extensively drug-resistant (XDR) Salmonella Typhi (Typhi) infections among U.S. residents without any history of travel to Pakistan or any other country. The CDC is providing information on these cases as well as clinical recommendations for the evaluation and management of typhoid fever and treatment recommendations for XDR Typhi infection.

In LA County, there have been no cases of XDR Typhi without linkage to international travel detected to date. Healthcare providers should report cases of typhoid fever within 1 working day to their local Public Health Department.
